



Residential Permit Parking: June 13 or June 16

It's time for parking permit renewal!

During the month of June each year, residents who hold a CURRENT residential parking permit may get their renewal decal through the TCNA service; those residents applying for a new parking permit must go to the City Parking Authority downtown. Rob Snow has been the coordinator for a number of years and requested to retire from this task. We will miss him and thank him for all of the time that he has spent doing this over the years. Ellen Silbergeld has volunteered to be the new coordinator.

Anyone who has a **CURRENT** residential permit will be notified by the City to pay the fee for the 2018-2019 on-line. If you renew your permit prior to June 13, Ellen will have your new permit decals for distribution before the TCNA annual meeting on June 13. You can come to Calvert School between 6 and 7 that evening. She will also be available in the lobby of the Colonnade on Saturday, June 16 between 10 and 2. Use the lobby entrance off of Canterbury Road that goes to the residences and not the one that goes to the Inn.

You will need to bring your CAR REGISTRATION to show proof of address. Registration fees must be paid in advanced. (We cannot accept payment)

If you do not pick up your decal on June 16th, Ellen has to return the unclaimed decals to the City Parking Authority. You will need to go to the Parking Authority with your registration to pick it from them. If you do not have a current permit, you must go in person to the Parking Authority where you will register and pay for a residential parking permit. Be sure to bring your car registration with you.

The Parking Authority is open from 9-5 Monday – Friday and is located at 200 W. Lombard Street Suite B, Baltimore, 21201 https://parking.baltimorecity.gov

Update on the Woods on Tuscany Road and Summer Construction at Calvert's Lower School

Since the signing of the Woods Agreement with Calvert in April, TCNA and the other Associations have sent written testimony to the Baltimore City Planning Commission and the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals in support of the sale of the property to Calvert, the construction of an educational building on it and the school's application for a conditional use for educational purposes. Everything went smoothly and Calvert received the necessary approvals from both City agencies.

With the Planning and Zoning hurdles behind them, Calvert is hoping to close on the purchase of the property sometime during the first week of July. Although students will be using the property for various purposes during the next school year, there are no plans for construction on the property this year.

The main entrance to the Calvert Lower School building on Tuscany Road is undergoing some improvements this summer. The loop will be removed with the hope that this will speed up the car pool line.
